


Articulation Agreement Between
Potomac State College of West Virginia University
And
Mineral County Schools

This agreement provides an articulation of credits to Potomac State College of West Virginia University (WVU) for students who complete the ProStart IA, IB, IIA, and IIB courses at the Mineral County Technical Center and who enroll at the College in the Hospitality and Tourism (HTOR) A.A.S. program.

This articulation agreement becomes effective for the 2006-2007 academic year. The agreement will be reviewed and updated and the effective dates extended prior to the start of each academic year.



Work-Based Learning Internship	HTOR 295—Internship Up to 6 credits	Approval of Potomac State College.
Business Computer Applications II	Computer Science 101 Computer Applications— 4 credits	Receive a grade of C or better on state competency exam.
Accounting I and II	Accounting 201 Principles of Accounting—3 credits	Equivalent of C or better on state competency exam.
	HTOR 120 Sanitation—2 credits	Sanitation certification from the National Restaurant Association.
	CHPR 172 First Aid and Emergency Care—2 credits	Up-to-date Red Cross CPR and first aid certification.




